

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter serves to verify that courses offered in partnership with **Wiley University Services – Advancement Courses (AC)** are designed specifically for graduate level continuing education purposes to help support educators in the advancement of their professional practice, stay current in the field and provide a pathway to SNHU degree-bearing opportunities.
